Event Summary

June 19th-29th Peru CE tour- A very appreciative thank you to Signet Tours, Best Choice Travels, and our tour participants for an incredibly memorable trip to Peru. I would also like to thank Dr. Chester Jeng for his two lectures on Employment Law and Dr. Steven Huang for his lecture on Dental Implants and Bruxism. In Peru, we travelled and ate well while visiting some wonderful places. During our stay, we visited the cities of Lima, Paracas, Urubamba, Cusco, Maras, Puno, Chinchero, and of course Machu Picchu. Our tour guides did a wonderful job introducing and explaining the culture and society of the modern day Peruvians and the Incans and Andeans of the past. We had a chance to sample and eat some very delicious and unique food and drinks during our stay as well. Some that stood out among the great Peruvian food we had were the Pisco sour(very high alcohol content), alpaca meat, giant Amazonian river snails and guinea pig(I took one bite which was plenty).

There were many places that we visited that were indescribable. In Paracas, some of us saw the Nazca lines inside a small single propeller airplane. Wonderful images or geoglyphs etched in the sandy soil between 500BC and 500AD by the Nazca culture. We saw hummingbirds, spiders, monkeys, a whale and even a person/astronaut waving. In Cusco, we saw some wonderful Spanish and Incan temples and cathedrals as well as Incan ruins with ridiculously large and heavy stones(up to 200 tons!!!). While we were in Cusco, the city was celebrating the winter solstice with a week long Sun Festival where locals dressed up in native attire and paraded and partied for a week. We visited Incan tombs, salt mines and crop circles that were all very special in their own right. Between these places we visited a world famous Peruvian ceramist and watched demonstrations on traditional Andean weaving with alpaca fur. In Lake Titicaca, we took a boat to meet with a group of natives that lived on the lake on manmade islands of reeds called totora. Of course the highlight amongst all these places was Machu Picchu. We were given a very informative tour and had a chance to hike and walk around the ruins. A small group of us also braved the difficult hike up Huayna Picchu. The spectacular views, great weather and the group that we travelled with, truly made Machu Picchu a once in a lifetime experience.

This is a highly recommended trip and something everyone has to do once in their life. Again thank you to Signet Tours, their wonderful tour guides and my 26 travelling companions who were like family on this vacation.
